Official denial is given to rumours that serious disturbances occurred this morning at Hammersmith, Putney, Chiswick and Poplar.

The report given out that two policemen were killed last night at Canning Town is declared to be without foundation.

Eight theatres closed. The Apollo, Shaftesbury, His Majesty's, Winter Garden, St. Martins, Adelphi, Gaiety Gaiety and the Savoy have closed as a result of the strike. Others may follow suit. The Stoll Picture Theatre will not close down under any circumstances.

There has been an increase of 20% in the Paris/London Aeroplane traffic. No delays and departures made to-day at normal hours.
