WIRELESS NEWS BULLETIN

Food

In London and the Home Counties the position remains satisfactory on the whole. The situation in the South Midland area has still further eased since yesterday, and the Civil Commission no longer feels any anxiety about foodstuffs. The position remains generally satisfactory throughout and there is little tendency for a crisis to arise.

The Commissioner for the North Western Division states that with reference to the proposed strike of the Birkenhead flour mills, the situation is easier, and there is a chance that the mtn will stay in.

The South Western Division expects that the shortage of flour at Plymouth will be relieved to-day by a special train from Bristol with 1,000 sacks.

720 tons of sugar unloaded at Bristol Docks yesterday without interference.

Transport

In a number of divisions no Sunday trains were running, but throughout the country it is anticipated that the service will be more adequate than on Saturday.

Road transport appears to be satisfactory in all divisions.
