WIRELESS NEWS BULLETIN.

MESSAGE RECEIVED FROM NO 10 DOWNING STREET.

At a meeting with the Prime Minister at 10 Downing Street, Mr. Pugh announced on behalf of the General Council of the T.U.C. that the General strike is being terminated to-day.

It does not appear necessary to add anything to it other than that some times of delicacy and perhaps difficulties may be encountered in the operation of reconstruction, to all engaged in which we naturally wish the success and satisfaction that their efforts deserve.

ANNOUNCEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE T.U.C.

In order to resume negotiations the General Council of the T.U.C. has decided to terminate the General Strike to-day, and telegrams of instructions are being sent to General Secretaries of all affiliated Unions. Members before acting, must await the definite instructions from their own Executive Councils.
